Credits which were of James Freeman late of Charles County Bankholder Deceased who Died Intestate
as to his Estate of Plea of Trespass upon the Case and so forth

And Whereas upon the same Bennett Administratrix vs. by Jeremiah Chase her Attorney Complaints
for that whereas the said William on the Ninth day of March in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven
Hundred and forty Seven at Charles County vs. was indebted unto the said James in his Lifetime in the
Sum of Three Pounds Seven Shillings and Ten Pence Currancy pravers Particulars being Properly in an
Account as by the Particular Account thereof turned into Court brought may appear and the said William
being so thereof indebted In Consideration whereof afterwards to wit the same Ninth day of March in
the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Seven at the County aforesaid upon himself
Assumed and to the same James Freeman in his Lifetime then and there faithfully Promised that he the said
William the said Sum of Three Pounds Seven Shillings and Ten Pence Currancy to the said James in his Lifetime
would well and truly Convey and Pay when thereunto afterwards he should be requested. Now whereas
the said William Smallwood Senior his Promise and Assumption aforesaid made not in the last
Regarding but minding and fraudulently intending him the said James Freeman In Part Craftily and
Subtilly to deceive and defraud the said Sum of Three Pounds Seven Shillings and Ten Pence Currancy
to him the said James Freeman in his Lifetime or to the said Bennett Administratrix after the Death of the said James
Freeman to whom Administration of all and Singular the Goods and Chattels Right & Credits which
