And the said Charles by Thomas Clark his Attorney Comes and defends the price and Injury which do  
for the. And afterwards to wit the same second Tuesday in June afo. as well the said William as the  
Charles do agree and Submit that the whole matter in Controversie between them be Determined by Walter  
Hanson Gent. Referee of the Court here of the Consent of the Parties afo. Especially appointed, whereupon  
it is writ to the said Walter by the Court these 26<sup>th</sup> and afterwards to wit the same second Tuesday in June afo. Comes as  
well this 17<sup>th</sup> as the said Charles by their Attorneys afo. as also the said Walter Hanson the Referee afo. with  
Return to the Court here the following award Vizt.

Charles Countess. The Subscriber being appointed by said County Court with the Consent of Parties to  
Determine the within Cause after having Examined the Witnesses & heard the Allegations on both  
Sides do find for the Plaintiff and Award Damage to two Thousand and ninety nine pounds of Tobacco  
Given under my hand this 8<sup>th</sup> of February 1729  
Walter Hanson

Whereupon the said William by his Attorney afo. prays Judgment to pass upon the Return of  
the Referee afo. in form afo. found for him to be given. It is there fore Considered by the Court here that  
the said William do Recover against the said Charles his Damages afo. to two Thousand and ninety  
Nine pounds of Tobacco. So as aforesaid by the Referee afo. awarded as also the sum of three  
Hundred and Eighty pounds of Tobacco for his Costs & Charges by him about his suit in this  
Part laid out and Expended by the Court here to the said William of his afo. by the Court  
Definitively adjudged and the said Charles Costs in May 26<sup>th</sup>

The Court Adjourns until the second Tuesday in  
August Next.
