August 9<sup>th</sup> 1759. We the Grand Jurors for the Body of Charles County do Present William Breeding for begetting a Bastard Child, on the body of Sarah Holley by Information of Mankins foreman

We do also present John Clark for Concealing his Son Moses as a Slave by the Information of Thomas Matthews. Mankins foreman

We do also Present Ann McFarthing for bearing a Muttatto Bastard, in the Opinion of this Jury. Mankins foreman

We do also present Edward Sweet for selling Liquor on his own Plantation contrary to an Act of Assembly in such Cases made and Provided, by Information of Nathan Harris. Mankins foreman

We do also Present Monica Waggott for bearing a Muttatto Bastard by Information of a Captain William Presley. Mankins foreman

Whereupon they are discharged and Allowed four Hundred Pounds of Tobacco.

Ordered that Clerk give Receipt on all Deventments found this Court.

Charles County sh<sup>t</sup>. Memorandum: That this day came before me one of his Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the County aforesaid Timothy McCar Daniel McCar and John Green and acknowledge each of themselves to be justly due to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary in the full and just sum of Fifty pounds Current Money, and together with them came Michael Jarrell their Surety, and acknowledge himself to owe and stand justly indebted to the said Lord Proprietary in the full and just sum of Fifty Pounds like money, to be levied of their several Bodies, goods or Chattels Lands and Tenements to the Use of the said Lord Proprietary his Heirs and Successors on Condition, that if Timothy McCar. Daniel McCar. John Green shall and do make their Personal Appearance before the Justices of Charles County Court next to be holden at Charles Town, then and there to Answer unto all such Matters or things as shall be laid to their Charge concerning a Ferry Boat being taken from Andrew Monroe, and not depart the Court without leave, then this Recognizance to be void and of none Effect, or Else to stand and Remain in full force and Virtue in Law.

And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in August a<sup>d</sup>. the a<sup>d</sup>. Timothy McCar Daniel McCar and John Green according to the Tenor of the Recognizance a<sup>d</sup>. and nothing material being against them alleged, they the said Timothy. Daniel and John together with their Surety James Michael Jarrell from the force and Effect of the same Recognizance were quit and Discharged saying they would give Warrantia de to the Officers, Ministers of the Court here by Omission of the Proprietary.
