Bet Remember'd that on this day to wit the second Tuesday in August a.s. into Court here in his proper Person comes Darby McLochlane according to the Tenor of certain Recoginiance taken before the Wm' Shippfull M' Richard Harrison one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for the County of: that is to say the said Darby McLochlane in the sum of Twenty Pounds Current Money of Maryland together with Andrew Monroe his Attorney in the sum of Ten pounds like Money for his the said Darby McLochlane as appear to testify for Proprietary against a certain Timothy McCan Daniel McCan and John Green from the force and Effect of the same Recoginiance are Acquited and Discharged.

William Rutherford appointed Surveyor in the Room of Henry Barnes senr.

William Beck on his motion to the Court is Admited to keep Ordinary at his House in Staney on Durham shore the giving Security according to the Describtions of the act of Assembly in those Cases late made and Provided.

Whereupon into Court here in his proper person comes the Esq^r William Beck and Acknowledged himself to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of Forty Pounds Current money of Maryland and also in like manner came Wm Matthews and Maximillian Matthews of same County and acknowledged themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his said Lordship in the sum of Twenty Pounds like money each which sum they and every of them severally Agreed and Granted should be made and Laid on their and Every of their Goods and Chattels lands and Immoveable to the use of his said Lordship his Heire and Succession. — On Condition that the said William Beck do keep good Rules and Orders and does not sufferable loose or Disorderly Persons to Sipple Gamble or Commit other disorders or Irregularities contrary to the true Intent & Meaning of the act of Assembly Concerning Ordinaries and for the Better Regulating Innholders and Ordinary Keepers within this Province. — Memorandum simpald in Court to the 5 of November Court next.

James Heap motioned the Court about a Mollatto Child named John Henry Heereupon the said Heap is allowed Three Hundred Pounds of Tobacco for maintaining the said Child till Nov: November Court Next.

Lord Proprietary Recoginiance.

William Bryan Discharged Paying His.

Bet Remember'd that on this day to wit the second Tuesday in August Court into Court here in his proper person comes William Bryan of Charles County according to the Tenor of certain Recoginiance taken before the Wm' Daniel of M' Thomas Linfor one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for the County of: that is to say the said William Bryan in the sum of Twenty Pounds Current Money together with Ann Nelly and Daniel Newland in the sum of Ten pounds like money each for his the said William Bryan's appearance to answer unto all such Matters and Things as shall be Objected against him in behalf of his Lordship and in the mean time keep the Peace and be of good Behaviour, and Especially towards Elizanor Landers of said County and shall not do or procure to be done any bodily Hurt to her that then this Recoginiance to be used otherwise to be and remain in full force Power and Virtue in Law. Whereupon the said Wm^r Bryan on his proper person comes into Court here Comes according to the Tenor of the Recoginiance
