WILLIAMS into Court here in his proper person Comes the aforesaid William Beck and Acknowledged himself to be and Stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietor in the Sum of Forty Pounds Current money of Maryland and also in like manner Came W^m Matthews and Maximilian Matthews of same County and Acknowledged themselves to be and Stand Justly Indebted unto his said Lordship in the Sum of Twenty Pounds like money Each which Sums they and every of them severally Yielded and Granted should be made and Levied on their and every of their Goods and Chattels lands and Tenements to the Use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors. ON CONDITION that the said William Beck do keep good Rules and Orders and does not suffer any loose or Disorderly Person to tipple Game or Commit other disorders or Irregularities Contrary to the true Intent meaning of the act of Assembly Concerning Ordinaries and for the better Regulating Innkeepers and Ordinary Keepers within this Province
