Ordered by the Court here that Daniel McCann do give Sufficient Security in the sum of Two Hundred Pounds Current Money for his Good Behaviour to and appearance here from day to day during the sitting of this Court. ^{to appear} Whereupon into Court here in their proper persons Came John Hamill and Thomas Morris of Charles County Planters and Acknowledge themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary in the sum of One Hundred Pound Current Money Each which sum they severally yielded and Granted should and might be Levied on their and Each of their Goods and Chattles Lands and Invements to and for the use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors. On Condition that the said Daniel McCann shall make his Personal appearance here from day to day during the sitting of this Court to answer unto all such things as shall be Objected against him on behalf of his Lordship the Lord Proprietary and to stand to and abide by the Judgment of the said Court, and in the mean time Keep the Peace and be of Good Behaviour to wards his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary and all other People of this Province, and not depart the same Court without Leave thereof.

Ordered by the Court here that Timothy Maccan Recognise in the sum of One Hundred Pound Current money with Sufficient Security in the sum of One Hundred Pound Like Money for his Good Behaviour to and appearance here from day to day during the sitting of this Court. ^{to appear} Whereupon into Court here in his proper person Came the said Timothy Maccan of Charles County Taylor and John Hamill of Charles County Planter and Acknowledge themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the sum of One Hundred Pound Current Money Each which sums they and Each of them severally yielded and Granted should and might be Levied on their and Each of their Goods and Chattles Lands and Invements to and for the use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors. On Condition that the said John Green shall make his Personal appearance here from day to day during the sitting of this Court to answer unto all such things as shall be Objected against him on behalf of his Lordship the Lord Proprietary and to stand to and abide by the Judgment of the said Court and in the mean time Keep the Peace and be of Good Behaviour to wards his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary and all other People of this Province, and not depart the same Court without Leave thereof.

Ordered by the Court here that Darby McLocklane Recognise in the sum of Forty Pounds Current Money with Sufficient Security in the sum of Twenty Pounds Like Money for his appearance here from day to day during the sitting of this Court to Testify for the Lord Proprietary against the said Daniel McCann and John Green. Whereupon into Court here in his proper person Came the said Darby McLocklane of Charles County and Andrew Monroe of same County Inholder and Acknowledge themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Darby McLocklane in the sum of Forty Pounds Current Money and the said Andrew Monroe in the sum of Twenty Pounds Like Money which sums they and Each of them severally yielded and Granted should and might be Levied on their and Each of their Goods and Chattles Lands and Invements to and for the use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors. On Condition that the said Darby McLocklane shall make his Personal appearance here from day to day during the sitting of this Court to Testify for his Lordship the Lord Proprietary against Timothy Maccan Daniel McCann and John Green and not depart the same Court without Leave thereof.
