To Peter Ward James Nicolson Samuel Church and Samuel Love Junior Gentlemen Whereas the Vestry of William and Mary Parish are Lord and Proprietors of a Parcel of Land called Gleebe Land lying in the said County did on the thirteenth day of June being in the thirty fifth year of our Dominion &c. Present their certain Petition in Writing to our Court that is to say to our County Court holden at Charles Town in and for the said County on the day aforesaid before Thomas Stone Gentleman and his Associates
