In Obedience therunto after having given such Notice as the Law in that Case made and Provided Directs) we did meet on the said Land and there did Examine all such Evidences as to us was Offer'd. Witness our hands and Seals this 31<sup>st</sup> day of July 1749.

Lord Proprietary Presentment for taking a Cow out of the Pasture of Henry Davis Belonging to Elizabeth Bryan Contrary to Act of Assembly &c. of Giles Green. Nulli prosequere

Beit Remember'd that here to fore to wit the second Tuesday in March last by the Oath of fifteen Jurors Namely Peter Wood &c. was Presented Giles Green for taking a Cow out of the Pasture of Henry Davis Belonging to Elizabeth Bryan Contrary to Act of Assembly &c.

And afterwards to wit the second Tuesday in June last the said Giles Green in Custody of the Sheriff Namely Samuel Hanson Gentleman to the Court here in his Proper Person Comes.

Whereupon it is ordered by the Court here that the said Giles Green Enter into Recognizance in the sum of Twenty Pounds Current Money with sufficient Security in the sum of Ten pounds like Money for his appearance at Good Behaviour to the Next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in August next to answer &c. Whereupon into Court here in his

Proper Person Comes the said Giles Green of Charles County Planter and John Rude Juniors same County Planter and do acknowledge themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Giles Green in the sum of Twenty pounds Current Money and the said John Rude in the sum of Ten pounds like Money which sums they and each of them severally yielded and granted should and might be made and levied on their and each of their goods

and Chattels Lands and Tenements to and for the Use of his said Lordship his Heirs & Successors. On Condition that the said Giles Green do and shall make his Personal appearance here at the Next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in August next to answer unto all such

Matters and things as shall be objected against him of and Concerning his taking a Cow out of the Pasture of Henry Davis Belonging to Elizabeth Bryan Contrary to Act of Assembly, and stand to and abide by the Judgment of the said Court and in the meantime keep the Peace and be of Good Behaviour towards his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary and all other People of this Province, and not depart the same Court without Leave there of.

And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in August the said Giles Green in his proper person Comes here as well as his said Lordships Attorney General as the said Giles in his proper person. And thereupon the said Attorney General saith he the Matter of &c. in the Presentment of &c. against the said Giles Green will not further Prosecute. Therefore it is considered that the said Giles from the same Presentment and matter therein contained be acquitted and Discharged.

Ruled that the said Giles Green do give Security for the several fees herein due to the Officers and Ministers of the Court here by occasion of the Premises. Whereupon into Court here in his Proper Person Comes Edmund Lottens of Charles County Gentleman and becomes Pledge and Security for the said Giles Green to pay the several fees aforesaid.
