Beth Remember'd that here to you to wit the second Tuesday in June anno 1728 by  
the Oath of fifteen Jams Name by Benjamin Grinnell Esq: was presented Sarah Goley for bearing a bastard  
Child. And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in August aforesaid Sarah Goley to the Court  
here in her Proper Person comes and being demanded of her by the Court here whether she be guilty  
of the said Party aforesaid upon her Imprisoned she the said Sarah Goley says she is then of guilty in  
manner and form as by the Presentment aforesaid against her it is alleged.

Whereupon it is ordered that the said Sarah Goley Enter into Recognizance In the sum of ten  
Pounds Current Money with sufficient security In the sum of Two Pounds Like Money for her appearance  
at the Next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in November Next to  
Answer aforesaid Whereupon into Court here in her Proper Person comes the aforesaid Sarah Goley of Charles  
County Spinster and Aleanderine of same County Blacksmith and acknowledge the Judgments to  
one and stand Justly indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that  
is to say the said Sarah Goley In the sum of Ten pounds Current Money and the said Aleanderine sum for  
the sum of Five Pounds Like Money which sum they and each of them severally quid and granted  
should and might be levied on their and each of their Goods and Chattels Lands and tenements to be  
for the use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors. ON CONDITION that the said Sarah  
Goley do and shall make her Personal appearance here at the Next County Court to be holden at Charles  
Town on the second Tuesday in November Next then and there to answer unto all such matters and things as  
shall be objected against her on behalf of his Lordship the Lord Proprietary and stand to an arbitre by the  
Judgment of this Court and in the meantime keep the peace and be of good Behavior towards his said  
Lordship the Lord Proprietary and other People of this Province, and no depart the said Court without leave  
thereof.

It was commanded the Sheriff that he should take Mary Birch late of Charles County widow  
of Mr: and her safe keep so that he should have her body before the Justice of the Lord Proprietary of  
his Next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in March Next to answer  
unto John Glare of Aplice of Imparle upon the last and aforesaid that he should have then and there that Glare  
At which day to wit the second Tuesday in March aforesaid Comes the said John by his Attorney Esq: his  
Attorney and others himself against the said Mary Birch and the Sheriff aforesaid Namely Samuel Hennic  
Gentleman Pictures to the Court here that he has taken the body of the said Mary Birch.

and Proprietary thereof to Imparle here until the Next Court to be holden at Charles Town  
on the second Tuesday in June next and the same day is given to the same John aforesaid
