Sarah Goley

Be it Remember'd that here to fore to wit the second Tuesday in June anno 1758 by the oath of fifteen Jurors namely Benjamin Lyman &c. was presented Sarah Goley for being indebted to Child. And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in August 1759 Sarah Goley to the Court here in her proper Person comes and being Demanded of her by the Court here whether she be guilty of the said Debt or not she answers she the said Sarah Goley says she is though guilty in manner and form as by the presentment aforesaid against her it is alleged

Whereupon it is ordered that the said Sarah Goley Enter into Recognizance in the Sum of ten Pounds Current Money with sufficient Security in the Sum of Five Pounds Like Money for her appearance at the next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in November Next to answer &c. Whereupon into Court here in her proper Person comes the aforesaid Sarah Goley of Charles County Spinster and Alexander Sims of same County Blacksmith and acknowledge the said Debt to one and stand Justly Indebted unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Sarah Goley in the Sum of Ten Pounds Current Money and the said Alexander Sims for the Sum of Five Pounds Like Money which Sums they and Each of them severally Gildes and Grants should and might be levied on their and Each of their Goods and Chattels Lands and Tenements to & for the use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors. ON CONDITION that the said Sarah Goley do and shall make her personal appearance here at the next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in November Next then and there to answer unto all such matters and things as shall be objected against her on behalf of his Lordship the Lord Proprietary and stand to an advice by the Judgment of said Court, and in the meantime keep the Peace and be of good Behaviour towards his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary and all other People of this Province, and not depart the same Court without License thereof
