

August Court Anno Domini 1749

And Whereupon the same Jemmett by Samuel Chase her attorney
 Complains that whereas a certain Daniel Brown late of Charles County Inhabitant of the said County in this Province of Maryland on the
 Twenty Eightth day of February last year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty four
 at Charles County afo: was indebted to the said James Freeman in his life in the sum of Fifty pounds of
 Tobacco and nine pounds four shillings and eleven pence currency for divers Goods and Articles lying
 properly in an account as by the particular Account thereof hereunto Court brought may appear
 which said Sums of Tobacco and Money now remain due and unpaid whereof the said Henry was not
 ignorant but maliciously and fraudulently intending him the said James Freeman in his lifetime
 of the Tobacco and Money afo: and of all means and Remedies for the Recovery thereof to deprive after the
 Publication of a certain Act of Assembly of this Province prohibiting all Masters of Ships or Vessels
 or any other Persons from transporting or conveying away any person or Persons out of this Province
 without Passes to wit the first day of April in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty
 five at Charles County afo: did transport and convey the said Daniel Brown over Potomack River
 into the Colony of Virginia the said Daniel Brown not having paid or satisfied the said Sums of Tobacco
 and Money or any Part thereof nor having any Pass from the Governour Keeper of the Great Seal or
 Secretary of this Province nor any Certificate from Two Justices of the County where in the said Dan:
 Brown resided and inhabited certifying his Freedom as the said Act of Assembly directs and the said
 Jemmett in fact saith that the said Daniel Brown the said Fifty pounds of Tobacco and nine pounds
 four shillings and eleven pence currency or any part thereof to the said James Freeman in his lifetime
 or to the said Jemmett since the death of the said James to which came Jemmett Administration of asst:
 Singular the Goods and Chattles Rights and Credits which were of the said James in due form of Law
 was committed by Master Hanson Gentleman Deputy Comissionary of Charles County afo: to
 whom the Granting the said Administration did of right belong did not satisfy or pay and that
 by Reason of the said Henry Thompson his transporting and conveying the said Daniel Brown over
 Potomack River into the Colony of Virginia as aforesaid by virtue of the said Act of Assembly the said
 Henry became and was liable to pay and Chargeable with the Payment of the said Sums of
 Fifty pounds of Tobacco and nine pounds four shillings and eleven pence currency to the said
 James Freeman in his life time. Yet the said Henry although Required the said Sums of Fifty
 Pounds of Tobacco and nine pounds four shillings and eleven pence currency or any part thereof to
 the said James Freeman in his life or to the said Jemmett since his death did not pay but the same to
 the said James in his lifetime and to the said Jemmett since his death to pay always both hether to
 Altogether Refused and the same to the said Jemmett to pay still doth Refuse to the damage of the said
 Jemmett One Hundred Pounds of Tobacco and Eighteen pounds nine shillings and eleven pence currency
 and therefore she brings Suit and so path and she also brings here into Court the Letters of Administration
 of the said James by which it may sufficiently appear to the Court here she is Administator tria as afo:
 and thereof hath Administration and so path.
