

# August Court Anno Domini 1729

As the said Act of assembly directs and the said Charles in fact saith that the said Dan: Brown the said three pounds twelve shillings and three pence Currency or any part thereof to the said Charles did not satisfy or pay and that by Reason of the said Henry his transporting and conveying away the said Daniel Brown over Potomack River into the Colony of Virginia as aforesaid by Virtue of the said Act of Assembly the said Henry Thompson became and is liable to pay and chargeable with the Payment of the said three pounds twelve shillings and three pence Currency Nevertheless the said Henry although often requested the said three pounds twelve shillings and three pence Currency or any part thereof to the said Charles Sanders hath not paid or satisfied but the same to him to pay or satisfy the said Henry Thompson hitherto altogether hath refused and still doth refuse therefore the said Charles saith he is injured and hath damage to the Value of seven pounds four shillings and six pence Current Money of Maryland aforesaid and therefore he brings Suit and so forth
