one of his Lordships Justices of the Peace for the County afo^r and made Oath on the Holy
Evangelists of Almighty God that the above Account is Just and True and that he hath not
Received any Part or Parcel Security or Satisfaction for the same to the best of his Knowledge
Sworn before Walter Hanson

Charles County s^t Whereas it has been made appear to me the Subscriber one of his
Lordships Justices of the Peace for the County afo^r that Patrick McGouran is indebted unto
M^r Hugh Mitchell In the Sum of One Pound Ten Shillings paper Currency and One pound
Eleven Shillings and Ten pence Virginia Currency as also that the said Pat^r McGouran is Runaway
These are therefore in his Lordships Name to Command you to issue attachment against
the Effects of the said McGouran as well to satisfy the said Debt as also the Incident Costs
that shall accrue thereon Pursuant to the Directions of the Act of Assembly or such Laws made
and Provided, fail not and this shall be your sufficient Warrant given under my hand and Seal
this 17th day of June 1719. — Walter Hanson Jr

Whereupon It was Commanded the Sheriff that of the Goods Chattels & Credits of the
aforesaid Patrick McGouran in his Bailiwick being he should attach as well the sum of One pound
Ten Shillings paper Currency and One pound Eleven Shillings and Ten pence Virginia Currency of
the Value of Two pounds Ten Shillings and Nine pence Maryland Currency Damages to be an
Hundred Pounds of Tobacco for Costs that had accrued and that further should none in Execution
of the Process and when the same he had attached or any part thereof that he should have it before
the Justice of the Lord Proprietary of his Neat County Court to be held at Charles Town on the
Second Tuesday in August next then and there to be condemned according to Law and for the
use of the said Hugh Mitchell unless the said Patrick McGouran should Complain and then
by himself or Lawfull attorney and Answer unto the said Hugh of a plea of Insufficiente these
and that by good and Lawfull men of his Bailiwick he should make the same Attachment
that he she or they be and appear before the Justice of the said Lord Proprietary at the Place and
Time afo^r to whom cause if any he she or they have why the sum is in their or any of their hands
attached should not he condemned according to Law and the said Hugh have therof Execution if
he and how he should execute that W^r that he should make known to the Justice afo^r at the
Time and Place afo^r and that he should have then and those that will and ther names of those before
whom he should make the same by whom he and now here at this day to witness the second
Tuesday in August afo^r comes the said Hugh by Humblet & have their attorney and offer himself
against the said Patrick in the place afo^r and ther attorney returns to the Court here the next afo^r thus
