unto William Middleton of a plea of Trespass upon the Case and so forth  
And Whereupon the same William Middleton in his proper person complains that whereas  
the said William Smallwood after the first day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred &  
five sheweth on the third day of August in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty  
four at Charles County afo. made his certain Note in Writing called a Promissary Note with the  
Paper hand and Name of him the same William Smallwood thereto subscribed and bearing date the day  
and year afo. and the same Note to the same William Middleton thence Delivered by which  
same Note the said William Smallwood Promised to pay unto William Middleton or his Order Eight  
Hundred and forty six pounds of Good Clean Tobacco in Cash to Contain the same for Value Received
