County May the 2^d 1719 Then came John Payne before me the Subscriber One of his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid and Made Oath on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God that the above Account is just and true and that he hath not Received any part or Parcel or Satisfaction nor any Security for the same, and further makes Oath that the Books where in the above Account stood stated was found in some as the Law directs before M^r Geo. Whereupon the said Subman^t Hartley by Jeremiah Chase their Attorney at Law and Singular the Revisors Required by Act of Assembly on part of the said Subman^t & Hartley being performed pray Judgment for the writ of the Lord Proprietary of Attachment to Issue Returnable here &c. against the Goods Chattles & Credits of the said Richard Roby in the Jurisdiction of the Court here being for as well the Damages as in the Declaration aforesaid mentioned as for what Costs have Curued and that further may Curue in Prosecution of the Premises. Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the said Subman^t & Hartley have the writ of the Lord Proprietary of Attachment Returnable here &c. against the Goods Chattles and Credits of the said Richard Roby within the Jurisdiction of this Court here being for as well the Sum of sixteen Hundred & Seventy six pounds and Three Quarters of a pound of Tobacco as all Costs which have Curued in and about the Premises and that may here after Curue in Prosecution of the said writ of Attachment by the Court here Adjudged according to the form fore and Effect of the Act of Assembly aforesaid.

Mr. H. Harrison's Judgment according to Verdict

Charles County sh^{ip} Joseph Harrison Harrison late of Charles County Planter otherwise called Jo^hn Harrison Harrison of Charles County, was summoned to answer unto John Simple of a plea that he owes unto him the Penal Sum of Six Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty which to him he owes and unjustly detains upon. And Whereupon the same John Simple by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney saith that whereas the said Jo^hn Harrison the Eighteenth day of November in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty eight at Charles County sh^{ip} by his certain Bill obligatory with the Seal of the said Jo^hn Harrison Harrison Sealed and here in Court brought whose date is the day and year aforesaid acknowledged to owe to the said John Simple the sum of Three Thousand four Hundred Twenty and five Pounds of Crop Inspected Tobacco to be paid to the said John Simple on or before the Twentieth day of January Next ensuing for Value Received of him, & the said Payment well and truly to be made and done the said Joseph Harrison Bound himself his Heirs Executors and Administrators in the aforesaid Six Thousand Eight Hundred and fifty for the payment of Three Thousand four Hundred Twenty and five pounds of Crop Inspected Tobacco, as aforesaid firmly by the said Bill and the said John Simple In fact saith that the said Joseph Harrison Harrison hath not paid to the said John Simple the aforesaid Sum of Three Thousand four Hundred Twenty and five pounds of Crop Tobacco, as aforesaid nor any part thereof upon the aforesaid Twentieth day of January which to him on the said day he ought to have paid according to the form and Effect of the Bill aforesaid by which action he hath Curued to the said John Simple to have & demand of the said Joseph Harrison Harrison the said Sum of Six Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty

Next the said Joseph Harrison Harrison altho' often Required hath not paid to the said John Simple the said Sum of Six Thousand Eight Hundred and fifty nor any part thereof but he thereto act together hath and still doth refuse to pay the same wherefore he saith he is the Worse and hath damage to the Value of Six Thousand eight Hundred and fifty Pounds of Tobacco and therefore writ is brought and verified. Whereupon the said Joseph Harrison Harrison by Thomas Clark his Attorney Comes and prays that the said John Simple he being a non-resident in the County aforesaid may give Security for the Cost of this (Joseph)
