Prince Geo: County Mary the 2^d 1749 Then came John Raynes before me the subscriber one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid and Made Oath on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God that the above Account is just and true and that he hath not received any part or Panel or Satisfaction nor any Security for the same, and further makes Oath that the Books wherein the above Account stood Stated was paid in Time as the Law directs before Mr Geo: Frazer One of his Lordships Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid. Sworn before *John Hawkins Junr*

Whereupon the said Subman Hartley by Jeamah Chase their Attorney &c alled singular the Powers Requisite by Act of Assembly on part of the said Subman Hartley being performed pray Judgment for the M^t of the Lord Proprietary of Attachment to issue Returnable here &c against the good Chattels & Credits of the said Richard Roby in the Jurisdiction of the Court here being for as well the Damage as in the Declaration aforesaid mentioned as for what Costs have accrued and that further may arise in Prosecution of the Summons. Therefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Subman Hartley have the M^t of the Lord Proprietary of Attachment Returnable here &c against the good Chattels & Credits of the said Richard Roby within the jurisdiction of this Court here being for as well the sum of sixteen Hundred & Twenty five pounds and three Quarters of a pound of Tobacco as all Costs which have accrued in and about the Summons and that may here after arise in Prosecution of the said M^t of attachment by the Court here Adjudged according to the formone and Effect of the Act of Assembly aforesaid.

Judg^m of J. H. Harrison's Judgment according to Law

Charles County s^t Joseph Hanson Harrison late of Charles County Planter otherwise called Jo: Hanson Harrison of Charles County was summoned to answer unto John Semple of apica that he render unto him the sum of six thousand eight hundred and fifty which to him he owes and unjustly detains upon And whereupon the same John Semple by Jeamah Chase his Attorney saith that whereas the said Jo: Hanson Harrison the Eighteenth day of November in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and forty eight of Charles County aforesaid by his certain Rite Obligatory with the Seal of this the said Jo: Hanson Harrison sealed and herein Court brought whose date is the day and year aforesaid owing to the said John Semple the sum of three thousand four hundred twenty and five pounds of Crop Inspected Tobacco to be paid to the said John Semple on or before the twentieth day of January next ensuing for value received of him, & the said payment well and truly to be made and done the said Joseph Hanson Harrison bound himself his Heirs Executors and Administrators in the aforesaid three thousand eight hundred and fifty for the payment of three thousand four hundred twenty and five pounds of Crop Inspected Tobacco, as aforesaid formerly by the said Bill on the said John Semple In fact saith that the said Joseph Hanson Harrison hath not paid to the said John Semple the aforesaid sum of three thousand four hundred twenty and five pounds of Crop Tobacco, as aforesaid nor any part thereof upon the aforesaid twentieth day of January which to him on the said day he ought to have paid according to the formone and Effect of the Bill aforesaid by which action he saith to the said John Semple to have & demands of the said Joseph Hanson Harrison the said sum of six thousand eight hundred and fifty Nevertheless the said Joseph Hanson Harrison saith often required hath not paid to the said John Semple the said sum of six thousand eight hundred and fifty nor any part thereof but hither to together hath and still doth refuse to pay the same wherefore he saith he is the Worse and hath damage to the value of six thousand eight hundred and fifty Pounds of £⁰⁰ and therefore suit is brought and now forth
