 Bop be being a Non Resident in the County aforesaid may give Security for the Costs which the said Richard may
 Expens in Prosecuting his Suit according to the Rule and Practice here Whereupon Jeremiah Chase
 of Charles County Gentleman and becomes pledge and Security for the aforesaid David that in case the
 David discontinues the plea aforesaid against the same Richard or in the same be Non Suit then he the said
 Jeremiah Chase yields and Grants that all and Singular the Costs which to the said Richard should be
 adjudged of his Lands and Chattles should be made and Levied unless the said David should Pay and
 Satisfie the same to the same Richard or his Body in Execution by Reason thereof Rendered
 Whereupon at the prayer of the said David it is Ruled that the said Richard Give Special Bail
 in the plea aforesaid and for want thereof the said Richard Present herein Court is committed into the
 Custody of the Sheriff Namely Samuel Hanson Gentleman thereto Remain until &c
 And the said Richard in Custody aforesaid by Thomas Clark his attorney aforesaid comes and defends the same and
 Injures when &c and saith that he cannot deny the Action aforesaid of him the said David nor but that he owes
 to the said David the sum of Four Thousand Pounds of Like Tobacco as the said David above in swearing
 supposes. Whereupon the said David by his attorney aforesaid prays Judgment of his debt aforesaid above
 Acknowledged together with his damages Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in this part laid out & Expens
 to him to be adjudged. Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the said David do recover against
 the said Richard his debt aforesaid to Four Thousand pounds of Like Tobacco above Acknowledged as also the sum of Two
 Hundred forty four Pounds and one half pound of Tobacco for his damages Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in this
 Definitive part laid out & Expens at his own cost by the Court here adjudged and the said Richard in Money &c

 Charles County aforesaid was indebted to the said Thomas in the sum of Twelve Hundred and Seventy pounds of
 Tobacco for divers articles lying properly in an account as by the Particular account thereof herewith into Court
 brought may appear and being sotherof indebted the said William in Consideration thereof afterwards to wit
 the day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid upon himself assumes and to the said Thomas then and there faithfully
 Promised that he the said William the said Sum of Twelve Hundred and Seventy Pound of Tobacco to the
 Thomas Hungerford when thereunto afterwards he should be requested within Truly would Content and
 Pay. Nevertheless the said William his Promise and Assumption aforesaid regarding but minding
 fraudulently Intending the same Thomas in this part Craftily and Subtletly to deceive and defraud the
 said William the said Sum of Twelve Hundred and Seventy pounds of Tobacco or any part thereof to the same
