And the said William by Thomas Clark his attorney comes and defends the fore and injury when &c. and the same attorney says that he is not informed of any answer to the said Thomas Hungerford for the said William Bryan in the plea aforesaid to be given and nothing other thereof does he say whereby the same Thomas Hungerford remains against the said William Bryan the said fore without defence. It is therefore considered by the Court here that the said Thomas Hungerford doth owe against the said William Bryan his Damages by occasion of the premises and which by the Justice of the Court here are assessed to Eleven Hundred and twenty pounds of Tobacco as also the sum of Two Hundred and thirty Pounds and Three Quarters of a Pound of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in this part laid out and expended to the said Thomas Hungerford of his Definitive Assent by the Court here adjudged and the said William Bryan in Mercy &c.
