And the a p. James in custody a p. by Wm. Adleton his attorney comes and defends the case and says that he cannot deny the action a p. of him the said Alexander Hawkins nor that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the said Alexander against him hath complained nor also but that the said Alexander hath sustained Damages by means of not performing the Promises and Assumptions a p. to Nine Hundred Pounds of Tobacco qualified as a fore said as the Alexander above in declaring supposes. Whereupon the said Alexander by his attorney a p. prays Judgment and those damages as acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in this part laid out and Expended to him to be adjudged Herefore it is considered by the Court here that the said Alexander do recover against the said James his damages a p. Nine Hundred pounds of Tobacco qualified as a fore said above acknowledged as also the sum of one Hundred twenty five p. and three quarters of a pound of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in this part laid out Def in med and Expended on his a p. by the Court here adjudged and the said James Mudd in 26.

Sanders of the same County and Province Plaintiff of a plea that he owes unto him the sum of Five thousand Pounds of Tobacco in kope Hogheads to him he owes and unjustly detains and so forth And whereupon the same Thomas by Jeremiah Chase his attorney saith that whereas the a p. Samuel Hodgkin the Twelfth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & forty nine at Charles County a p. by his certain Bill obligatory with the seal of him the said Samuel Sealed and herein Court produced whose date is the day and year a p. acknowledged himself to owe to the a p. Thomas Two thousand four hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco in kope Hogheads to be paid to the said Thomas on demand and the same payment well and truly to be made the said Samuel obliged his Heirs & assigns in the a p. sum of Five thousand pounds of like Tobacco firmly by the said Bill and the a p. Sam. Hodgkin afterwards satisfied to the said Thomas Two thousand and six hundred pounds of Tobacco Part of the a p. sum the said Thomas in fact saith that the a p. Samuel Hodgkin hath not paid to the said Thomas the sum of Two thousand Two hundred and forty four pounds of like Tobacco residue of the a p. sum on demand nor any part thereof to him on demand he ought to have paid according to the form and effect of the Bill a p. by virtue of which action hath awarded to the said Thomas to have and demand of the a p. Samuel Hodgkin the a p. sum of Five thousand Pounds of like Tobacco nevertheless the said Samuel Hodgkin altho often Requested to wit on the Twelfth day of July in the year and at the County a p. the sum of Five thousand Pounds of like Tobacco to the said Tho. hath not paid but that to him hither to, to pay hath Refused still doth Refuse to the damage of the said Tho.
