And the said Samuel in his proper person comes and defends the same & injury wherein he and saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of him the said Thomas nor but that he owes to the said Thomas the sum of Five thousand pounds of like Tobacco in manner and form as the said Thomas above against him complains Wherefore it is Considered by the Court here that the said Thomas doth recover against the said Samuel his debt aforesaid and his damages by occasion of detaining that debt to Two hundred & Fifty five pounds and one Daffined half pounds of Tobacco to the same Thomas on his account by the Court here Adjudged and this Samuel in meny &c

¶ James Mudd & Judgment of Cognovit Actionem

Charles County s: James Mudd late of Charles County Planter otherwise called James Mudd of Charles County Planter was Summoned to Answer unto William Skyrin Merchant of a plea that he render unto him the full and just sum of twelve hundred and Eighty six pounds of Tobacco which to him he owes and unjustly detains and so forth And Whereaspon the same William by Jeremiah Chase his attorney saith that whereas the said James Mudd the Nineteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred and forty Eight at Charles City aforesaid by his certain writing Obligatory granted himself to be held and firmly bound unto the aforesaid Wm Skyrin in the aforesaid sum of twelve hundred and Eighty six pounds Tobacco to be paid to the aforesaid Wm Skyrin at or upon the Tenth day of April next ensuing the date of the writing obligatory aforesaid with legal Interest for the same NEVER THE LESS the said James Mudd as he often Required the aforesaid sum of twelve hundred and Eighty Six Pounds Tobacco nor any part thereof to the said William Skyrin hath not Rendered or Paid but theremeto him to render and pay both hither to altogether refused and still doth Refuse to pay the same wherefore he hath this worse and hath damage to the value of Two thousand five hundred and Twenty two pound Tobacco therfore he brings Suit and he bringeth hereto Court the writing obligatory aforesaid which the debt aforesaid is to witness whose date is the same day and year first aforesaid and so forth I Chas: H.
