Then came Mr^r W^m Skyrin before me one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for said County and made oath on the holy Evangelist that the above account is Just and True & that he hath not Directly or Indirectly to the best of his knowledge Received part or parcel thereof for any Satisfaction or other Security for the same.

And the said Samuel Shuron in his proper person comes and defends the peace and Injuries when Mr^r and saith that he cannot deny the Action w^{ch} is from the said Mess^{rs} Stephenson & Co nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the said Stephenson & Co against him Complaints nor also but that the said Stephenson & Company have Sustained damages by means of not Resuming the Promises and Assumptions w^{ch} to Eight Hundred and Ninety Seven pounds of Tobacco as the said Stephenson & Company above in dubbing supposed. Whereupon the said Stephenson and Company by their Attorney w^{ch} pray Judgment and those damages w^{ch} acknowledged together with their Costs and Charges by him about their suit in this part laid out and Expended to him to be Adjudged. Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the said Stephenson & Company do Recover against this Samuel their Damages w^{ch} to Eight Hundred and Ninety Seven pounds of Tobacco above acknowledged as also the Sum of one Hundred and Eighty Two pounds of Tobacco for their Costs and Charges by him about their suit in this part laid out and Expended on his Assent by the Court here Adjudged.

Case David Pops Debt

vs Math^w Stone Judgment According to Law

Charles County sh^r Matthew Stone late of Charles County Planter otherwise called Matthew Stone of Charles County Maryland was Summoned to answer unto David Pops of a plea that he render unto him the penal Sum of Six Thousand pounds Good Sound Clean Tobacco or Cash which to him he owes and unjustly detains on as forth. And Whereupon the same David Pops by his Advocate Chase his Attorney saith that in view as the said Matthew Stone the Eighth day of October in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Seven at Charles County sh^r by his Certain Bill Obligatory with the seal of him the said Matthew Stone sealed and herein Court brought whose date is the same day & year aforesaid acknowledged himself his Heirs Executors Administrators or assigns to owe to Mess^{rs} Reid and Stewart or Mr^r David Pops or to the Order of either the Sum of three Thousand Pounds Good Sound Clean Tobacco or Cash which he should at least One Thousand on or before the first day of November Next to come after the date of the said Writing Obligatory and the same Payment well and Truly to be made and done the said Matthew Stone himself his Heirs Executors Administrators or assigns in the aforesaid Sum of Six Thousand Pounds like Tobacco or as aforesaid for the Payment of Three Thousand Pounds like Tobacco or as aforesaid jointly by the said Reid and the said David Pops in respect with that the said Matthew Stone hath not Paid to the said David Pops or Mess^{rs} Reid & Stewart or either of them the aforesaid Sum of Three Thousand Pounds like Tobacco or as aforesaid.
