William Stewart Judgment according to Law

Charles County s^r. William Stewart late of Charles County Planter otherwise called William Stewart of Charles County Planter was summoned to answer unto Hugh Mitchell of a plea that he owes unto him the full and just sum of Eighteen Hundred and sixty pounds of Tobacco to him he owes and unjustly detains and so forth. And whereupon the same Hugh by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney saith that whereas the said William Stewart the Seventeenth day of May in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Nine at Charles County s^r. by his Certain Writing Obligatory granted himself to be held and firmly bound unto the s^r. Hugh Mitchell in the s^r. sum of Eighteen Hundred and sixty pounds of Tobacco and the s^r. William Stewart afterwards did satisfy and pay unto the said Hugh Mitchell the sum of Two Hundred and seventy Pounds of Tobacco Part of the s^r. sum of Eighteen Hundred and sixty Pounds of Tobacco and the s^r. Hugh in fact saith that the said William Stewart did not pay and satisfy the sum of Six Hundred and sixty pounds of Tobacco residue of the s^r. sum of Nine Hundred and thirty pounds of Tobacco upon demand nor any part thereof which to him upon demand he ought to have paid according to the form and effect of the Writing Obligatory a^s. by which condition hath accrued to the said Hugh to have and demand of the s^r. William the s^r. sum of Eighteen Hundred & sixty pounds of Tob^o. Nevertheless the said William a^s. often required to wit on the Tenth day of July in the year and at the County s^r. the said sum of Eighteen Hundred and sixty pounds of Tobacco hath not been paid or paid but the same to him to tender and pay hath hitherto altogether refused and still doth refuse to pay the same wherefore he saith he is the more and hath damage to the value of Three Thousand Pounds of Tobacco and therefore he brings Suit & he brings hereinto Court the Writing Obligatory a^s. which the s^r. inform a^s. Testifies whose date is the same day and year first a^s. Ho forth
