

# August Court Anno Domini 1719

And Credits which were of James Freeman late of Charles County Innholder Deceased who Died Intestate as to his said estate of Treasurys upon the same and so forth And Whereupon the same Jennet Administratrix a/c. by Jeremiah Chase her attorney Complains that whereas a certain Solomon Vinton late of Charles County a/c. Ship Carpenter was on the Nineteenth day of June in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty five at Charles County a/c. Indebted to the said James Freeman in his Lifetime in the sum of Thirty Three pounds Sixteen Shillings and Seven pence paper currency for divers Articles Goods & other things properly chargable in an account by the said Solomon from the said James in his Lifetime then and there had and Received which remains due and unpaid and the said Solomon so thereof being indebted in Consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid at Charles County a/c. upon himself assumed and to the said James Freeman in his Lifetime then and there faithfully fully Promised that he the said Solomon the said Sum of Thirty Three pounds Sixteen Shillings and Seven pence paper currency to the said James when thereunto afterwards he should be required well and truly would Content and pay and the said Jennet Administratrix saith that the said John Norton aforesaid to wit on the second day of December in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty five at Charles County a/c. in behalf of the said Solomon and in Consideration of the Debt aforesaid upon himself assumed and to the said James then and there faithfully promised and undertook to pay and satisfy to the said James Freeman the said Sum of Thirty Three pounds Sixteen Shillings and Seven pence paper currency from the said Solomon Vinton as aforesaid Justly due and owing and the said Jennet further saith that the said Solomon Vinton did never pay or satisfy to the said James Freeman in his Lifetime or to her the said Jennet since the death of him the said James the said sum of Thirty Three pounds Sixteen Shillings and Seven pence paper currency or any part thereof NEVER THE LESS the said John Norton his Promise and Assumption a/c. not regarding but minding and fraudulently Intending the said James in his Lifetime and the said Jennet since the death of him the said James to which said Jennet Administratrix of all and Singular the Goods and Chattels Rights and Credits which were of the said James was on the Thirty first day of March in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Eight at Charles County a/c. in due form of Law committed by Walter Hanson Gentleman Deputy Commissioner of Charles County a/c. to whom the Granting of the said Administratrix did of Right belong in this part Craftily and Subtilly to devise and defraud the said Sum of Thirty Three pounds Sixteen Shillings and Seven pence paper currency or any part thereof to the said James in his Lifetime or to the said Jennet since the death of the said James hath not paid or contented altho so to do the said John Norton was afterwards to wit on the first day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Seven and often since at Charles County a/c. by the said James in his Lifetime thereto Requested and by the said Jennet Administratrix aforesaid after the death of the said James to wit on the tenth day of April in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Eight and often since at Charles County aforesaid thereto Requested but the same to pay or satisfy he the said John Norton to altogether hath Refused and still doth Refuse wherefore the said Jennet saith she is Injured and hath damage to the Value of Sixty Seven pounds Thirteen Shillings and Two pence paper Currency and therefore she brings suit and she brings hereinto Court the Letters of Administration aforesaid of him the said James Freeman by which it sufficiently appears to the Court here she is Adm<sup>r</sup> a/c. and that Administration thereof was to her Granted and so forth
