And Credits which were of James Freeman late of Charles County Inhabitant Deceased who Died Intestate as his said of a plea of Trespass upon the Case and so forth And Whereupon the same Jennett Administratrix aforesaid. by Jeremiah Chase her Attorney Complains that whereas a certain Solomon Vinton late of Charles County aforesaid Ship Carpenter was on the Nineteenth day of June in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty five at Charles County aforesaid. Indebted to the said James Freeman in his Lifetime in the sum of Thirty Three pounds Sixteen Shillings and Seven pence paper Currency for divers Articles Goods & other things properly chargeable in an account by the said Solomon from the said James in his Lifetime then and there had and Received which remains due and unpaid and the said Solomon so there of being indebted in Consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid at Charles County aforesaid upon himself assumed and to the said James Freeman in his Lifetime then and there faithfully Promised that he the said Solomon the said Sum of Thirty Three pounds Sixteen Shillings and Seven pence paper Currency to the said James when thereunto afterwards he should be Requested well and Truly would Content and pay and the said Jennett in fact saith that the said John Marten afterwards to wit on the second day of December in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty five at Charles County aforesaid in behalf of the said Solomon and in Consideration of the Debt aforesaid upon himself assumed and to the said James then and there faithfully promised and undertook to pay and satisfy to the said James Freeman the said Sum of Thirty Three pounds Sixteen Shillings and Seven pence paper Currency from the said Solomon Vinton as aforesaid Justly due and owing and the said Jennett further in fact saith that the said Solomon Vinton did never pay or satisfy to the said James Freeman in his Lifetime or to her the said Jennett since the death of him the said James the said Sum of Thirty Three pounds Sixteen Shillings and Seven pence paper Currency or any part thereof NEVER the less the said John Marten his Promise and Assumption aforesaid not regarding but minding and fraudulently Intending the said James in his Lifetime and the said Jennett since the death of him the said James to which said Jennett Administration of all and Singular the Goods and Chattles Rights and Credits which were of the said James was on the Thirtieth day of March in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Eight at Charles County aforesaid in due form of Law committed by Walter Hanson Esquire Deputy Commissary of Charles County aforesaid to whom the Granting of the said Administration did of Right belong in this part craftily and Subtly to deceive and defraud the said Sum of Thirty Three pounds Sixteen Shillings and seven pence paper Currency or any part thereof to the said James in his Lifetime or to the said Jennett since the death of the said James hath not paid or contented altho so to do the said John Marten was afterwards to wit on the first day of May in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Seven and often since at Charles County aforesaid by the said James in his Lifetime thereto Requested and by the said Jennett Administration aforesaid after the death of the said James to wit on the tenth day of April in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Eight and often since at Charles County aforesaid thereto Requested but the same to pay or satisfy he the said John hath to altogether hath Refused and still doth Refuse wherefore the said Jennett saith she is Injured and hath damage to the Value of Sixty Seven pounds Thirteen Shillings and Two pence paper Currency and therefore she brings Suit and she brings here into Court the Letters of Administration aforesaid of him the said James Freeman by which it sufficiently appears to the Court here she is Adm: aforesaid and that Administration thereof was to her Granted and so forth
