Ordered by the Court here that Richard Gambre do get the several Standard Measures that is wanting, and bring in his Account against the County

John White makes Oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that he destroyed Ninety six Squirell Heads last year for which he has had no Allowance, whereupon he is Allowed One Hundred and Fifty Three pounds of T^b. in this present Levy
