Lord Proprietary, Breach of the Peace

Hugh Redman & Convict on Submission

Beit Remembered that here to wit the Second Tuesday in November afo. by the Oath of Fifteen Jurors Namely Samuel Hawkins &c. was Presented Hugh Redman for a Breach of his Lordships Peace on the body of Richard Myan.

And after was detoured the Second Tuesday in November afo. Hugh Redman into Court here in his proper person Comes and being demanded of him by the Court here Whether he be Guilty of the Breach of the Peace afo. so on him Imposed he shewed Hugh saith that he is in no wise thereof Guilty but for that he will not contend with his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in this Part Humbly submits himself to the Court. Therefore it is Considered that the said Hugh Redman before the sum of one Shilling Current Money for the offence afo. by the Court here to judge so and that the said Hugh Redman be taken by the Sheriff of the County of Charles into Court here in his proper Person Committed Robert Morrison of Charles County and becomes Pledge and Surety for the said Hugh Redman to pay the fine aforesaid and also the several fees arison due to the officers and Ministers of the Court here by Occasion of the Premises.

Ordered by the Justices of the Court here that Negroe Glen the slave of Mr. John Wheatly Committed by Captain Davies on suspicion of Felony, and nothing appearing against the said Negroe he is Discharged from the Custody of the Sheriff.

Ordered by the Justices of the Court here that Negroe Forreger the slave of Doctor Brown Committed by Mr. Robert Yates on suspicion of Murder, and nothing appearing against the said Negroe, he is Discharged from the Custody of the Sheriff.

John Gray Junior makes Oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that he destroyed Seventy One Squirrel heads pro. he has had no allowance. Whereupon he is allowed one Hundred and Thirteen Pounds and Three fifths of a pound of Tobacco.

John Gray Senior makes Oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that he destroyed Sixty Seven Squirrel heads pro. he has had no allowance. Whereupon he is allowed Ninety Nine Pounds and one fifth of a pound of Tobacco.

James Gray makes Oath on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God that he destroyed One Hundred & Eleven Squirrel heads pro. he has had no allowance. Whereupon he is allowed One Hundred & Seventy four Pounds and three fifths of a pound of Tobacco.
