The Road from Stones Mills to George Elgins Row and the Road that Strikes out of that Road to Nanjerry Church and Wagapolls Road from Nanjerry Road to Thomas Westalls & the Road that Leads from Monalwoods by John Daviss to Nanjerry Church and also a Road from Peter Woods Quarter the usual way to John Gray's Englishman and through his Plantation and from thence through the Woods till it intersects Mr. Wagners Smallwoods Church Road

The Road the West and East Side Lachiah New Bridges also a Road to begin at a small Path by which there is marked a black Oak sapling on the Left of an old and usual Way that Leads from Lachiah New Bridges Round the head of Jordan Branch and so to Livattaway with the said small Path till it intersects a path that Leads from Edwards Jenkins Mill to Robys Place then with the said Path towards said place about two Miles then striking out of said Path on the right at a marked Oak and leading then with the marked trees to either Robys and then to an old Path which leads by the Plantation of Benjamin Doyers and so into Mr. William Middletons Road & Leads to Fortbaw then with and then the said old Path as convenienty Leads to Mr. W. Middletons Road with the said Town

The Road from Birds Creek to the Worshipfull Capt. Richard Harrison and to Mr. Robert Dades and to Maryland Point and also a Road to begin near the first bound tree of Thomas Hudsons Land Called Sabithas Lot. To turn to the Eastward along a Key until it Comes to a path formerly a Road, then with the said Path to dividing line between Williams his son and Joseph H. Harrison then with the said division line to the Road which leads from the head of Birds Creek to Nanjerry Church and also a Road to turn out of the Road which leads to the Worshipfull Captain Richard Harrison along the old path towards the long wharf then by Joseph Legibays Cornfield and Orchard to the Ware House. From Mr. Robert Dades the usual Way to the Ware House and from thence by James Muncasters to Kings Point the Mouth of Nanjerry Creek
