Charles County to wit the Jurors for the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that there is for the body of Charles County appeared and upon their oath present that Negroe James Slave of Charles County aforesaid Saboured the Slave of a certain Ledstone Smallwood of Charles County aforesaid Hunter on the Twenty second day of April in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty five with force and Arms one horse of the Price of five pounds Stealing the proper horse of a certain Roger Smith of the County aforesaid Hunter at Charles County aforesaid being he the said Negroe James then and there with force and Arms the said Horse feloniously stole took and led away against the Peace of the said Lord Proprietary his good rule and government and Contrary to the act of a assembly in such case made and Provided
