Charles County vs. You Richard Reeder William Sutherland and Benjamin Reeder do confess Judgment to David Ross for the sum of Two Thousand One hundred and forty five pounds of tobacco Damages and Two Hundred and Forty four Pounds and a half pound of tobacco Costs which sum were recovered by the said David Ross against Richard Reeder on the Eighteenth day of August Seventeen Hundred and Forty Nine in the said County Court the said sum of Two Thousand One hundred & forty five pounds of tobacco Damages and Two Hundred and Forty four Pounds & a half Pound of tobacco Costs which said sum to be levied of your Body's goods or Chattels Lands or tenements for the use of the said David Ross in case the said Richard Reeder shall not pay unto the said David Ross the said sum of Two Thousand One hundred & forty five pounds of tobacco Damages and Two Hundred and Forty four Pounds and a half Pound of tobacco Costs recovered against him with the additional Costs theron on the tenth day of February next

Charles County to wit the Juries for the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that now is for the body of Charles County aforesaid do upon their Oath present that Negro James Slave of Charles County aforesaid Labours the Slave of a certain Limestone Smallwood of Charles County aforesaid Master on the Twenty second day of April in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and forty nine with force and Arms one horse of the value of twelve pounds making the proper horse of a certain Roger Smith of the County aforesaid Master at Charles County aforesaid being he the said Negro James then and there with force and Arms the said Horse feloniously stole took and led away against the Peace of this said Lord Proprietary his Good Rule and Government and Contrary to the act of Assembly in such Case made and provided.
