And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in November aforesaid the aforesaid Negro James in custody of the Sheriff Namely Samuel Hanson came to the Court here brought in his proper person Comes And being demanded of him by the Court here howe of the Felony aforesaid above to him Answered himself he would acquit the said Negro James says that he is not thereof Guilty in manner and form as by the Indictment aforesaid against him it is supposed and for Tryal whereof for God and I the people himself upon the Country and furnish Chare Gallerian who for the Lord Proprietary in this part setteth also It is therefore Commanded the Sheriff that he cause to come here immediately a Jury of the County aforesaid the Town aforesaid of the Jurys by the Sheriff aforesaid thereto forsworn being called over that is to say John Hanson Junior Francis Dunnington Michael Abby Richard Lambre William M'Pherson Thomas Morris John M'Pherson John Chandler Holland Middleton Thomas Jackson Hatch Denton Shadwell Lady who to speak the Truth in the Premises being Called tryed & sworn upon their Oath do say that the said Negro James is not guilty of the Felony aforesaid manner & form as by the Indictment aforesaid against him it is supposed Whereupon the said Negro James and the Subject matter therein contained from the force and Effect of the same Indictment is Acquit & Discharged

Lord Proprietary Recoguiance  
Hugh Redman Discharged

Vide p[ro]p[ri]et[or] folio 282 Remeber'd that on this day to wit the second Tuesday in November aforesaid comes here Hugh Redman according to the Tenor of a certain Recoguiance taken here on the second Tuesday in March last and continued respited to this Court for his the said Hugh Redman appearance here &c. And afterward to wit the same Tuesday in November aforesaid John Hammill Surety for the aforesaid Hugh Redman deliver him upto the Court. Whereupon the said John Hammill from the force and Effect of the same Recoguiance is Acquit & Discharged. Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the said Hugh Redman Auguise in the sum of Twenty p[ounds] Current Money of Maryland with one Surety in the sum of Ten pounds like Money for his Good Behaviour to and appearance here from day to day during the setting of this Court to December &c. Whereupon into Court here in his proper person Comes the aforesaid Hugh Redman and Robert Morrison of same County and acknowledge themselves to owe and stand Justly Indebt[ed] unto his Lordship the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary that is to say the said Hugh Redman in the sum of Twenty Pounds Current Money of Maryland and the said Robert Morrison in the sum of ten p[ounds] like Money which sum they and each of them severally yielded and granted should and might be made and levied on their and each of their Bodys Goods and Chattels lands and Tenements to end for the use of his said Lordship his Heirs and Successors ON condition that the said Hugh Redman to make his personal appearance here from day to day during the setting of this Court to answer unto all such matters and things as shall be objected against him on behalf of his Lordship the Lord Proprietary and stand to and abide by the Judgment of the said Court and in the meantime keep the peace and be of good Behaviour towards his said Lordship the Lord Proprietary and all other People of this Province and not depart this same Court without Leave thereof And afterward to wit the same second Tuesday in November aforesaid Hugh Redman into Court here in his proper person comes according to the Tenor of the Recoguiance aforesaid taken here this Court for his the said Hugh Redman appearance here. Whereupon nothing mystical being Alleged against the said Hugh Redman he and his main person from henceforth shall that the said Hugh Redman to give Surety for the sum of fees aforesaid due to the Officers and Ministers of the Court here by occasion of the Premises. Whereupon into Court here in his proper person comes Robert Morrison of Charles County to make a pledge and Surety to pay the several fees aforesaid
