 James Freeman late of Charles County Inhabitant Deceased who Died in Estate as tis said as well the  
 Sum of Fifty pounds of Tobacco and Nine pound four shillings and Eleven pence Currency which to the said  
 Jennett Adm. of the Court of the said Lord Proprietary before the Justices of the said County was adjudged for her Damages  
 which she had by reason of a Breach Promise and Assumption to the said Jennett Adm. of the County  
 of the said County made and Unperformed as also Two Hundred & seven pounds and one Quarter of a pound of Tobacco which  
 the same Jennett Adm. of her Account were adjudged for her Costs Charges by her about her suit in this part  
 laid out and Expended. Whereof the said Henry Thompson is Convicted H. C. and that he should have them  
 there that the H. C. M. now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in November of the said County

 Administrators in Case the said Henry Thompson shall not pay and Satisfy to the said Administrators the  
 Sums so as aforesaid against him with the additional Cost thereon on the tenth day of February next

Charles County for. It was Commanded the Sheriff, Whereas John Cooke Esq. lately in the Court of the Lord  
 Proprietary. That he say his County Court held at Upper Marlborough Town the fourth Tuesday of June in the  
 thirty fourth year of the Dominion of the Lord Proprietary before Edward Spragg Gentleman and his  
 Associates Justices of the said County Court had Recovered against William White late of Prince Georges County  
 Clerk otherwise called William White of Prince Georges County as well the sum of four hundred and twenty  
 four pounds of Tobacco a certain Debt as also the sum of Two Hundred Ninety six pounds one half pound of Tobacco  
 which to the same John of his Account by Discretion of the Justices of the said County of Prince Georges were adjudged for  
 his Damages which he had by reason of detaining the Debt & whereas also the said John pursuant to the Directions of  
 the Act of Assembly in these Cases made and provided lately before the Justices of his said Lordships Court the Justice  
 his County Court holden at Charles Town in and for the same County of Charles on the second Tuesday in August last  
 before G. Stoughton Esq. Chief Justice of his said Lordships Charles County Court Produced a  
 Transcript of the Records of the said County of Prince Georges County attested by the  
 Clerk of the same County Court and thereon by Consideration of his said Lordships Justices of Charles County Court  
 had Judgment that Execution should issue against the said William White for as well the Debt as in the said  
 mentioned as the sum of One Hundred & ninety eight pounds and one half pound of Tobacco which to the same John  
 at his Request by Discretion of the Justices last aforesaid were adjudged for his additional Damages whereof the said  
 White is Convicted that he should take the aforesaid William White if he shall be found in his Bail which then safe  
 keep so that he should have his body before the Justices of the Lord Proprietary of his Next County Court to be  
 holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in November next to satisfy unto the said John Cooke Esq. the  
 Debt
