Sum of Four Thousand pounds of Tobacco Fifty Six pounds four Shillings and Ten pence Currency to the said Samuel when thereunto afterwards he should be requested well and truly would Content and pay. Never theless the a^d. Edward his Promise Assumption a^d. not Regarding but minding and fraudulently Intending the same Samuel in this part craftily Subtly to deceive and defraud the a^d. Edward the a^d. Sum of Four Thousand pounds of Tobacco and Fifty Six Pounds four Shillings and Ten pence Currency or any part thereof to the same Samuel hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort Contented altho the a^d. Edward was on the Sixteenth day of October In the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Nine and often afterwards at Charles County a^d. by the same Samuel hath been Requested but the same to him hither to pay or him for the same in any sort to Content hath hither to altogether Refused and still doth Refuse to the Damage of the same Samuel Luckett Eight Thousand pounds of Tobacco One Hundred pounds Currency and therefore Suit is brought to the Court.
