The Justices aforesaid at the time and place aforesaid and that he should have then and there that writ and the Names of those before whom he should make the same return made
 And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in November 1759. Came the said
 John Mudd by William Middleton his attorney and offered him self against the said John
 Insley in the Pleas: and the Sheriff of Returns to the Court here the Sheriff of the County
 Charles County Jt. Thereby certify to the Justices within mentioned that
 by virtue of the writ therein mentioned the said John Insley on the 17th day of October 1759 attached in the hands

 Costs within mentioned as the Effects of the within named John Insley and for the
 Use of the within John Mudd and have made known to the Gaemasters aforesaid
 mentioned that they be and appear before the Justices at the time and place
 within prescribed to show cause if any he has, why the said Effects is attached in
 his hands should not be condemned according to Law to and for the Use of the said John
 Mudd before Thomas Howard, James Middleton Junr, William Courts, Richard
 Thompson, George Thomas and William Hungerford Jt. Good and Lawfull men of
 my County as I am by this writ commanded to Answer

And the said Clement Mudd in obedience in his proper Person came and Confessed that at the time
 of laying the attachment aforesaid he had and still has of the Effects of the said John Insley to the Value of
 three Hundred and Sixty four pounds of Tobacco and more, and also in Leds Thomas Crane
 Ignatius Gardner and Confessed that at the time of laying the attachment aforesaid he had and still has
 of the Effects of the said John Insley to the Value of one Hundred and Sixty pounds of Tobacco and
 more. Whereupon the said John Mudd by William Middleton his attorney aforesaid praye
 Condemnation of the sum of Tobacco aforesaid in the hands of the Gaemasters aforesaid, and by them
 Confessed with Execution thereof to him to be adjudged. Therefore it is considered by the Court
 here that the said John Mudd have Condemnation of the sum of Tobacco aforesaid in the
 hands of the Gaemasters aforesaid by the Court here adjudged according to the form here and Effect of
 the act of assembly in such Cases late made and Provided and that the said John
 Mudd have thereof Execution of
