Whereupon into Court herein their Proprs Persons Comers Jacob Clements and William M^{or} of Charles County Planters and business Pleas and Jurats for the s^d Jeremiah Mudd and William Mudd that if it should happen the s^d Jeremiah and William in the s^d Pleas: Should be bound that then the s^d Jacob and William Velled and Granted that as well Dist^{ts} as as Damages & Costs which to the s^d David Ref^s in & in this part should be adjudged of their Lands and Chattels should and ought be Lived to and for the Use of the s^d David Ref^s that if it should happen the s^d Jeremiah Mudd and William Mudd the Debt Damages & Costs to the s^d David should not pay or their Bodies into the Custody of the Sheriff by Reason thereof. Summoned to answer unto Edward Maltingly of plea that he owes unto him Three thousand pounds of Good Tobacco in three s^d. which to him he owes and unjustly Detains & with

And Whereupon the same Edward by Jeremiah Chase his attorney with that where the s^d Nicholas the fourth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty seven at Charles County s^d. by his certain Writing Obligatory obliged himself his Heirs &c. to pay unto the s^d Edward Maltingly his heirs or assigns in the s^d Three thousand pounds of Good Tobacco before the tenth day of November which shall be in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty eight to be paid to the s^d Edward when the same shall be required. Nevertheless the s^d Nicholas altho' often times required to wit the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and forty seven and often times at Charles County s^d: the s^d Three thousand pounds of Good Tobacco was ap. to the s^d Edward hath not yet answered but that to him to render altogether refused and still doth refuse wherefore he hath to in the same and hath Damages to the Value of Six thousand of Good Tobacco as an ap. and therefore he brings Suit and s^d and brings his writs into Court the Writing Obligatory s^d. which the Dist^{ts} inform ap. the s^d s^d date to the same day and year s^d.
