Charles County s^r. Joseph Hanson Harrison late of Charles County Planter was attached to Answer unto Thomas Hungerford of a plea of Trespass upon the Case and so forth And thereupon the same Thomas by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney complains that whereas the said Joseph Hanson the first day of January in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred & forty Eight at Charles County afo. was indebted unto the said Thomas in the sum of Thirteen Hundred and forty four pounds of Tobacco for several articles lying properly in an account as by the particular Account thereof herewith into Court brought may appear and being so thereof Indebted the afo. Joseph Hanson in Consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day's year afo. at the County afo. upon turne of Oath and to the said Thomas then and there faithfully Promised that he the afo. Joseph Hanson the afo. sum of Thirteen Hundred and forty four Pounds of Tobacco the said Thomas when the same afterwards he should be requested to deliver and truly would Content and pay. **NEVERTHELESS** the afo. Joseph Hanson his Promise and Assumption afo. not regarding but standing and fraudulently Intending the same Thomas in this part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the afo. Joseph Hanson the afo. sum of Thirteen Hundred and forty four pounds of Tobacco or any part thereof to the same Thomas hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort Contented altho the afo. Joseph Hanson was on the Tenth day of June in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Nine and often afterwards at Charles County afo. by the same Tho. Hungerford hath been Requested but the same to him hitherto altogether Refused and still doth Refuse to the Damage of the same Tho. Hungerford Two Thousand Six Hundred and Eighty Eight pounds of Tobacco and therefore Suit is brought under foorth
