Injunct upon H.C. and with that he cannot deny the action of them the said Thomas nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the said Thomas above against him hath complained nor also but that the said Thomas hath sustained damages by means of not performing the Promises and Assumptions afo. to Eight Hundred and Forty Three pounds of Shew and Nine Shillings and Nine pence farthing Currency as the said Thomas above in declaring supposes. Whereupon the said Thomas by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney afo. prays Judgment and those damages so acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in this part laid out and Expended to him to be adjudged. Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the said Thomas do recover against the said Robert Edwell his damages afo. to Eight Hundred and Forty Three pounds of Shew and Nine Shillings and Nine pence farthing Currency above acknowledged as also the sum of One Hundred and Eighty four pounds and one half pound of Shew for his Costs & Charges by him about his Suit in this Def. in said part laid out and Expended on his behalf by the Court here adjudged and the said Robert in Mercy &c.

R. Thomas Mudd. Judgment of Hon. sum Court afo. Damages owing to the Charles County. Thomas Mudd late of Charles County, Clerk was attached to answer unto Thomas Hungerford a plea of Trespass upon the Case and so forth. And whereupon the same Thomas by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney complains that whereas the said Thomas Mudd the first day of January in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred & forty Eight at Charles County afo. did indebted to the said Thomas Hungerford in the sum of fourteen Hundred & twenty One and a half pounds of Shew and six pence Articles lying & specially in an account as by the Particulars hereof hereunto into Court brought may appear and being so indebted the afo. Thomas Mudd in consequence afterwards to wit the day and year afo. upon himself assumed and to the said Thomas Hungerford then and therefor fully promised that he the said Thomas Mudd the said sum of fourteen Hundred & twenty One and a half pounds of Shew to the said Thomas Hungerford would well and truly content and pay when thereunto afterwards he should be requested. Nevertheless the said Thomas Mudd his Promise and Assumption afo. in form afo. made not in the least Regarding but minding and fraudulently Intending him the said Thomas Hungerford in this part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the said Thomas Mudd the said sum of fourteen Hundred & twenty One and a half pounds of Shew or any part thereof to the said Th. Hungerford hath not paid or in any sort contented altho so to do the said Thomas Mudd upon the sixth day of July in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Nine and often before and since at Charles County afo. by the said Th. Hungerford Requested but the said Thomas Mudd the said sum of fourteen Hundred & twenty One and a half pounds of Shew in any sort to content hath hither to altogether Refused and still doth Refuse to the said Thomas Hungerford Two Thousand Nine Hundred & forty Three pounds of Shew and therefore the said Th. Hungerford
