Charles County J^r Jeremiah Mudd & Thomas Quarmen Mudd late of Charles County Planters otherwise called J^r Mudd & Thomas Quarmen Mudd both of Charles County was Summoned to Answer unto W^m Shyrin & Hugh Mitchell of a plea that they Render unto them the full and Just debt of Three thousand Pounds Crop Tobacco which to them they owe & Unjustly detain & so forth And whereupon the same W^m Shyrin & Hugh Mitchell by Jeremiah Chase their Attorney say that whereas the said Jeremiah Mudd and Thomas Quarmen Mudd the Twentieth day of August in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred & thirty Nine at Charles County &c. by their certain Writing obligatory Granted themselves to be held & firmly bound unto the said W^m Shyrin & Hugh Mitchell in the said Sum of Three thousand Pounds Crop Tobacco to be paid to the said W^m Shyrin & Hugh Mitchell in thirty day after date thereof never the less the said Jeremiah Mudd and Thomas Quarmen Mudd at the often since Required the said Sum of Three thousand Pounds Crop Tobacco any part thereof to the said W^m Shyrin & Hugh Mitchell hath not Rendered or paid but that the same to them to Render & pay both hither to altogether Refused and still doth Refuse to pay the same Wherefore they say they are the more and have damage to the Value of Six thousand Pounds Crop Tobacco and therefore they bring suit and they bring hither to Court the Writing obligatory aforesaid which the said Jeremiah Mudd & Thomas Quarmen Mudd doth acknowledge is the same day and year aforesaid and so forth

And the said Jeremiah & Thomas Quarmen by their Attorney aforesaid Come and defende the said Writing when & so forth and pray appearing of the Writing obligatory aforesaid that the said Jeremiah Mudd & Thomas Quarmen Mudd doth acknowledge the said Writing obligatory of the said Jeremiah Mudd & Thomas Quarmen Mudd to the said W^m Shyrin & Hugh Mitchell in the full and Just debt of Three thousand Pounds Crop Tobacco to be paid to the said W^m Shyrin & Hugh Mitchell or their certain Attorney Es^r Adam or a Person, two such payment instant truly to be made and done, we bind our selves our Heirs Es^r & Adam &c. Jointly & severally by these Counts & sealed with our seals and dated this fourteenth day of August 1719 The Condition of the above Obligⁿ is such that if the above bound Jeremiah Mudd & Thomas Quarmen Mudd do pay or Cause to be paid in Thirty day after date hereof the whole debt with Costs of James Mudd due to W^m Shyrin & Hugh Mitchell as Judgment obtained last Charles County Court against said James Mudd then the above obligation to be void else to remain in full force & Work in Law
