Therefore it is Considered by the Court here that the said Richard do recover against the said John Masterson his Damages to seven pounds six Shillings Currency and Two Hundred pounds of Tobacco above acknowledged as also the sum of one Hundred and forty Two pounds and Three quarters of a pound of Tobacco for his Costs and Charges by him about his suit in this part laid out and Expended on his Account by the Court here adjudged and the said John Masterson in May 1729
