 of Two Thousand five Hundred and sixteen pounds of Tobacco Nine Shillings and two
 Pence Currency to the said Samuel Hanson would well and truly Content and pay when
 thereunto afterwards he should be requested Nevertheless the said Jeremiah Aderton his
 Promise and Assumption afo. not Regarding but minding & fraudulently Intending the
 same Samuel in this part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the said Samuel Hanson
 the said sum of Two Thousand five Hundred and sixteen pounds of Tobacco & Nine Shillings
 and two pence Currency nor any part thereof to the said Samuel Hanson hath not Paid or paid
 for the same in any sort Contented with the said Jeremiah Aderton afterwards to wit the first
 Day of October in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Nine and often
 afterwards at Charles County ap. by the said Samuel Hanson hath been requested but the
 same hath refused, to pay for him for the same in any sort to Content with his other allegations
