Wife Henry Davis Attachment on Warrant

Edw. Davis, son of Henry Davis, Condemnation for 265. Tobacco

But Remembered that Henry Davis Pursuant to the Directions of the last of Assembly in such Cases late made and provided lodged with the Clerk of the Court have the following Note and Warrant for Attachment Viz^t—

This my Note shall oblige me Edward Davis, son of Henry Davis to pay unto Henry Davis Senior, the sum of Three Thousand pounds of Crop Tobacco to be paid by the Tenth day of October Next Ensuing as Witness my hand this 22^d of May 1729

Charles County sh. On the Twentieth of August 1729 came Henry Davis and made Oath that he never had any part or parcel of the within Note or any security or satisfaction for the same to the best of his knowledge.

Charles County sh. You are hereby required to Hue Attachment on the within Note against the Effects of Edward Davis Son of Henry Davis for the sum of Three Thousand pounds of Crop Tobacco and the like that may accrue thereon, and for your so doing this shall be your sufficient warrant Given under my hand and seal this Twentieth day of October 1729.

Whereupon it was commanded the Sheriff that of the Goods Chattels & Credits of the afo. Edward Davis son of Henry Davis in his Bailiwick being he should attach as well the sum of Three Thousand pounds of Crop Tobacco Damages as One Thousand pounds of Tobacco for loss to that had accrued and that further should accrue in Execution of the premises and when the same he had Attached or any part thereof that he should have it before the Justice of the Lord Proprietary of his Next County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the second Tuesday in November next there and there to be condemned according to Law to and for the use of the said Henry Davis Senior unless the said Edward should come then and there by himself or Lawfull Attorney and Answer unto the said Henry Davis Senior of a plea of Treachery upon the case and that by Good and Lawfull men of his Bailiwick he should make known to the person or persons in whose hands he should make the same Attachment that he or they be and appear before the Justice of the said Lord Proprietary at the place and Time afo. to show Cause if any he or they have why the sum in their or any of their hands Attached should not be condemned according to Law and the said Henry Davis Senior have the execution of it. And how he should make known to the Justice afo. at the Time and place afo. and he should have then and there that W^t and the Names of those before whom he should make the same known &c. And now here at this day to wit the second Tuesday in November afo. comes the said Henry Davis by William Muddleton his attorney and offers himself against the said Edward Davis in the plea afo. and the Sheriff afo. returns to the Court here the W^t thus Indorsed Viz^t Charles County sh. To the Hon^rshipfull the Justices within mentioned that by Virtue of the within W^t to me Directed on the 1st day of November 1729 I attached Sunday the Effects of the within Named Edward Davis Son of Henry Davis, and for the use of the within Henry Davis as by a Schedule of Appraisement hereunto annexed will make appear, and I have made known to the above Garnantee that he be and appear before the Justices within mentioned and at the Time and place within Described, to show Cause if any he has, why the said Effects so attached in his hands should not be condemned according to and for the use of the afo. Henry Davis before John Pigeon and James Guley two Justices and Lawfull men of my Bailiwick.
