Wm Holl Middleton Judgment p. Cognovit Actionem

It was Commanded the Sheriff that he should take Holland Middleton late of Charles County Planter of Vt. and him self keep so that he should have his body before the Justices of the said County of his Neck County Court to be holden at Charles Town on the Second Tuesday in November Next he should make Robert Scott of plea of Traspas upon the Case & so forth here of full not Vt. and that he should have then & there that Writ Vt. And now here at this day to wit the Second Tuesday in November aforesaid comes this Robert by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney and offers himself against the said Holland in the plea afo. and the Sheriff aforesaid returns to the Court here that he hath taken the body of the said Holland Middleton And the said Holland by William Middleton his Attorney comes and defends the force and Injuryp afo. and swears that he is innocent the Action aforesaid of him the said Robert not but that he owes to the said Robert the sum of Nine Hundred & fifteen pounds Crop Tobacco and no more Whereupon the said Robert by his Attorney afo. Crays Judgment and Damages so acknowledged together with his Costs & Charges by him about his suit in this Court laid out & Expended to him to be adjudged. Therefore it is Considered that the said Robert sues against the said Holland his damages afo. for Nine Hundred & fifteen pounds Crop Tobacco above acknowledged as also the sum of One Hundred & thirty four pounds & one Quarter of a pound of Crop Tobacco for his Costs & Charges by him about his suit in this Court laid out & Expended on his behalf by the Court here adjudged and the said Holland Middleton in Money Vt.

ff. Robert M'horn Judgment p. Cognovit Actionem

Charles County vs. Robert M'horn late of Charles County Planter was attached to answer unto Robt Scott of plea of Traspas upon the Case and so forth

And M'horn reports the same Robert Scott by Jeremiah Chase his Attorney complains that where as the said Robert M'horn the Twenty first day of October In the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred & forty Eight at Charles County afo. was Indebted unto the said Robert Scott in the sum of Nine Hundred & thirty and three Quarters of a pound of Crop Tobacco for divers Articles lying properly in an account as by the Particular Account thereof herewith unto Court brought may appear and being so thereof Indebted the aforesaid Robert M'horn in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid at the County aforesaid upon himself assumed and to the said Robert Scott then and there faithfully promised that he the aforesaid Robert M'horn the aforesaid sum of Nine Hundred & thirty and three Quarters of a pound of Crop Tobacco to the said Robert Scott when he next afterwards he should be requested well and truly would Content and pay. Nevertheless the aforesaid Robert M'horn his promise and Assumption aforesaid not regarding but minding and fraudulently Intending the same Robert Scott in this part craftily and Subtly to deceive and defraud the aforesaid Robert M'horn the aforesaid sum of Nine Hundred & thirty and three Quarters of a pound of Crop Tobacco or any part thereof to the same Robert Scott hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort Contented altho the aforesaid Robert M'horn was on the Wednesday of June In the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and forty Nine and often afterwards at Charles County aforesaid by the same Robert Scott hath been Requested but the same to him hitherto to pay or him for the same in any sort to Content hath hitherto altogether Refused and still doth Refuse to the Damage of the same Robert Scott Eighteen Hundred Sixty one and a half Burds of Crop Tobacco and therefore suit is brought two for the
