

# March Court Anno Domini 1729

Joseph Druggles aged sixteen years the 27<sup>th</sup> of this Instant March Chooses Charles Druggles as his Guardian, who being Present in Court accepts of the same Guardianship.

Joseph Manning Presents Edmund Parrott his Servant to be adjudged for Run away time, whereupon he makes oath that the said Parrott Absconded himself Twelve days from his Service. Therefore it is adjudged by the Court here that this Parrott owe his said Master five days for One.

Ordered by the Justices of the Court here that Thomas Richards being Present here in Court in his proper person, for want of <sup>Security</sup> be committed into the Custody of the Sheriff namely Sam. Hanum Care Sheriff must remain until the Next Provincial Court to be holden at the City of Annapolis on the Second Tuesday in April Next for Suspension of Horse Stealing &c. and to abide by the Judgment of the said Court, and to depart the Court then without Leave there of.

Aquila Churn aged fifteen years the 15<sup>th</sup> of this Instant March Chooses William Loe as his Guardian, who being Present in Court accepts of the same Guardianship, and ordered to give Security for the said Estate before he Removes the same.

John Lee aged about fourteen years old the Eleven th day of December. Next is by the Court here bound to Philip Wood, who Engages to Teach him the Art and Mystery of a Taylors Trade & to Improve him in his Reading and Writing, and to give him a decent Suit of Apparel when free. Thomas Camwood and Nathan Harris being Grand Jurymen, solemnly Called Come not but make default, whereupon they are fined according to Act of Assembly.

Ordered by the Justices of the Court here that the Sheriff for the Future Summons Three Grand Jurymen more.

Matthew Barnes Sworn to 5 days Attendance for Aaron Nalley & Charles Smoot. For which he is allowed One Hundred & Twelve Pounds and one half pound of Tobacco.

John Branchling Sworn to 5 days Attendance for Peter Culver on Petition of Joseph Doyle for which he is allowed Ninety Pounds of Tobacco.

Benjamin Davis Sworn to 7 days Attendance for Peter Culver on Petition against Joseph Doyle for which he is allowed One Hundred & Fifty Seven Pounds and one half Pound of Tobacco.

William Cox Sworn to 7 days Attendance for Peter Culver on Petition against Joseph Doyle, for which he is allowed One Hundred & Fifty Seven Pounds and one half Pound of Tobacco.

Mary Sutton Sworn to 5 days Attendance for Peter Culver on Petition against Joseph Doyle, for which he is allowed One Hundred and Twelve Pounds & one Half pound of Tobacco.

Richard Neit Sworn to 6 days Attendance for Aaron Nalley against Charles Smoot for which he is allowed One Hundred and Thirty Five pounds of Tobacco.
