

Annapolis Plats, surveys, etc. Box 7

Mar. 27, 1820 - Report of Commissioners appointed to open East St. (+ plat and survey by John Duvall)

Act of Assembly 1819 - " An act to open and extend East St. in the City of Annapolis, and to close up that part of said street leading to Pr. Geo. St."

Committee of Corp recommends assent to proceedings of Commissioners, but says that Commissioners have made conditional valuation of damages sustained by proprietors of Lot 86. Committee doesn't feel Commissioners have right to do this. Some of the owners are minors. Committee wants provision in act for appeal of owners if unsatisfied by valuation.

Resolves that Commissioners be entitled to make valuation and pay damages out of city treasury.

Plat by Duvall shows:

Charles Carroll of Car. as owning part nearest above Pr. Geo.

Mrs. Delilah Holland as owning larger piece above Carroll's.
