" The court bind Charles a person of colour (he being 12 yrs of this day & by consent of his mother she being present in court) to Chas Carroll of C. Esq. until he arrives to the age of 21 yrs. The said Chas Carroll of C. is to cause the said Chas. to be taught the trade of a blacksmith & agrees to find him in sufficient meat, drink, washing & lodging & also ~~for~~ necessary clothing & also to have him instructed in reading, writing & arithmetic as far as the rule of three & at the expiration of his servitude to pay his freedom dues agreeably to Act of Assembly in that case made & provided."

Carroll of C. is to cause the said Will to be taught the trade of a blacksmith & agrees to find him in sufficient meat, drink, washing & lodging & also necessary clothing & also to have him instructed in reading, writing & arithmetic as far as the rule of three & at the expiration of his servitude to pay him his freedom due agreeably to an Act of Assembly in that case made & provided."
