Harrison willed estate to children of his good friends; DR Jas. Walker, Revd West, Daniel Bowley, Richard Ridgley in order to avoid state confiscation of property. His desire was to give his estate to his relatives in G.B., and was working out legal matters with his lawyer friends Thos Johnson + Richd Ridgley, but illness came too quickly for getting an act presented and passed in Assembly. There was thus a long dispute on the estate of Harrison between his eyes & the state of Md. (13)

Decision was that land should be confiscated, but by Act of Assembly 1789, State's claim was negated + property passed to executors as heirs (14)

His principal heirs were his nephew John Harrison, of Lincolnshire, England, his niece Elizabeth Irvine, of County Sligo, Ireland, and his execut<sup>e</sup>rs, WILLIAM WEST (1739-1791), DANIEL BOWLEY (1745-1807), and RICHARD RIDGELY (1755-1824). A dispute arose after Harrison's death over whether or not his estate left to his British heirs should be confiscated. LUTHER MARTIN (1744-1826) <sup>Attorney General, argued</sup> ~~agreed~~ for the commissioners of confiscated British property that Harrison had intended to devise the bulk of his property to his execut<sup>e</sup>rs in trust ~~of~~ for his British relatives and therefore the property should be confiscated. West, Bowley, and Ridgely denied any such trust arrangement and claimed the property as their own. Although the cha<sup>n</sup>cellor's decree was in favor of the commissioners, an Act of Assembly passed in 1790 removed the matter from the Chancery Court and negated the ~~st~~ate's claim to Harrison's estate.
