A letter of this date received from Edward Gaither Junr.  
late Commissary Anne Arundell County — advises that there are some barrels  
of Public Flour remaining in Mr. Thomas Tillards Mill, on Patuxent,  
that was manufactured last Spring — that he had applied to Mr. Willson to  
receive it, which he has not done — requests the Intendant to appoint some  
Person to receive it, as he says, he cannot settle his Account until this  
Flour is received for.

Letter dated the 7<sup>th</sup> instant received from Rich<sup>d</sup>. Tilghman's

business for them — he wishes the Intendant to draw an Order on him for  
the Horse, upon which he will deliver him up
