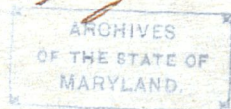


Baltimore 13 Juny 1784

Sir

I was not honor'd with the receipt
of your letter of the 3th instant till this
morning.

In consequence of your request I
dispatched 5 doz. of Windsor Chains, which have been
finished some time, but could not be sent
down on acct. of the Ice - they cost 2s/3 each
and amount to £ 63. 15. 0 - I shall be much oblig'd
if you will remit me this Sum, having already
sent 60 dollars and must pay the remainder in
a few days -
