Governor McKeldin said yesterday he has bought the home of W. Maclean Patterson at 103 Goodale road, in Homeland, for \$56,500.

Preparing to return to Baltimore as the end of his term draws near, Mr. McKeldin said the four-bedroom home of red brick is "the kind of house I've been looking for."

The Governor said he has bought three homes and sold three in Baltimore since he moved to Annapolis eight years ago. A home on Taplow road was bought a few weeks ago, he reported, but he acted quickly to buy the Patterson home when he learned it was available, and sold the Taplow road residence yesterday.
