

DEATH OF JOSIAH BAILEY, ESQ.

We regret to learn that Josiah Bailey, Esq. died at his residence in Cambridge, Dorchester county, on Friday last. Mr. Bailey was for a long time the Attorney General of Maryland, has served with distinction in the State Legislature, and was perhaps the oldest member of the bar in this State, at the time of his death. He had been for some years afflicted, so as to debar him from the active duties of his profession, and had lived for some time in comparative privacy. He was very far advanced in years, having outlived nearly all his youthful compeers, and, from the nature of the disease with which he suffered his death has been expected for some time. He enjoyed a very high reputation at the bar where he practiced, and shared very largely in the esteem and confidence of his fellow citizens.—*Bal. Pat. of 17th Aug.*
