

DEATH OF THE LATE ATTORNEY-GENE-

RAL OF MARYLAND.—We learn with deep regret that the venerable Josiah Bailey, Esq. for many years, and until recently, Attorney General of Maryland, died at Cambridge on Friday evening last. His advanced age had incapacitated him for several years from participating in the active duties of his profession, and he was finally compelled to resign the office of Attorney General, and retire to the shades of private life. He was several times a member of the Legislature, and at the time of his death the oldest and most respected member of the Bar in the State.
